CAMP DIRECTOR JERRY ABRAHAM Head Volleyball Coach

Jerry Abraham is entering his 23rd season as the head coach of the Madonna University volleyball team. In his tenure at the helm of the Crusaders program, Abraham has accumulated a 877-224 career record.

The Crusaders have won 12 consecutive WHAC championships under his guidance and have advanced to 11 NAIA National Championship Tournaments, including the last seven straight.

Abraham is one of the top coaches the game has ever seen, ranking second among active NAIA volleyball coaches in victories and is one of just five coaches at all college levels to eclipse the 800 win plateau.

A 2004 NAIA and Madonna University Hall of Fame inductee, coach Abraham was named the 2005 NAIA and AVCA National Coach of the Year after leading his team to a 48-2 record and NAIA Final Four berth. MU finished that season ranked #3 in the nation and added four more All-American's to the programs continually growing list of dominant players including a National Player of the Year and National Libero of the Year Runner Up.
