SUNDAY FALL BASKETBALL League \$150

Madonna University's Sunday Fall Basketball League has quickly become the best fall league in Metro-Detroit for players age 10-18. The league is geared toward the player who has worked hard all summer to develop his skills and would like to perfect them through game experience. The league meets every Sunday afternoon from September 18th through October 30th at Madonna University. Each team will play one or two games each Sunday. Teams are coached by Madonna University men's basketball players and will receive individual in-game instruction. Teams will not practice during the week. Each player will receive a reversible game jersey and will play a minimum of eight games.

Due to overwhelming demand we will be reorganizing the league for 2011. The SFBL will be divided into three divisions of five teams.

POST CAMP \$125

Madonna University's third annual Post Camp is designed to develop the overall skill level of high school post players ages 14-18. The camp will focus on back to the basket moves, face up moves, shooting, ball handling, rebounding, defensive position, setting and defending ball screens and much more. Each player will receive an individual evaluation as well as a personal DVD with shooting instruction and more. Madonna University's post camp is a training style, no frills, camp designed for those serious about learning and improving. The camp will run Monday through Friday, August 1, 5, from 4:30 to 8 p.m.

PERIMETER CAMP \$125

Madonna University's fourth annual Perimeter camp is designed to expose high school players, age 14-18, to college level training and drilling. We will focus on the fundamentals of basketball and give detailed instruction on shooting, ball handling, defensive position and footwork, communication, using and setting ball screens, shooting off the dribble and on the move and much more. Every player will also be given a personal DVD with beginning of camp footage of their shooting form and end of camp footage with additional instruction so that learning will take place long after camp ends. Perimeter camp will run Monday through Friday, August 1-5, from 4:30 to 8 p.m.

Holding the Post/Perimeter camp simultaneously allows for combined drilling in off ball screens, including double screens and stagger screens, ball screen offense and defense and for 5 on 5 play each day.
